### **Assembly :**

Assembly : 1h30

Disassembly : 1h30

Floor space for assembly : 18m par 6m

No equipment or personnel required.

### **Size of the machine :**

**High:** 3,60 m / **Wide :** 1,90 m / **Length:** 5,10 m / **Weight :** 1,7 t

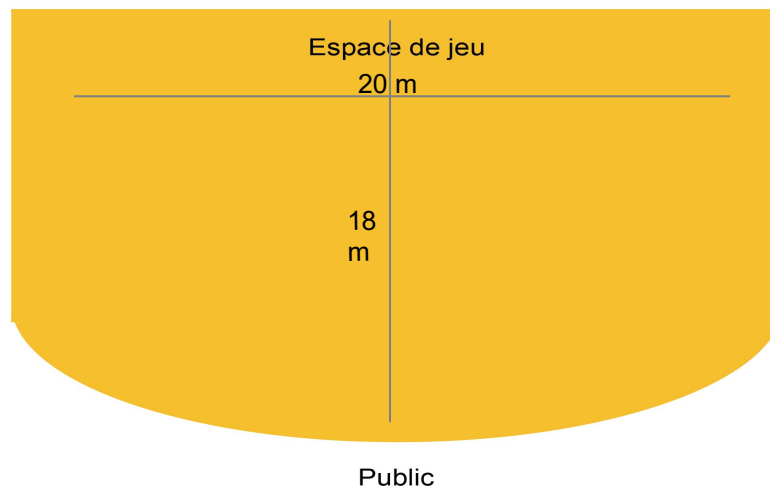
### **Home show and artistic team:**

- Provide accommodation and meals for 6 people (including a vegetarian meal).
- Provide dressing rooms with electrical points, washrooms and showers, tables and mirrors, warm-up space and light catering.

The fixed show lasts about 40 minutes and requires a playing space of 18x20m ideal or 16x18 minimum. The show requires a flat surface. We delimit the playing space by a lap (provided by us).

A walk can also be programmed (400m) but it should preferably take place after the show leaving a sufficient pause time between performances.

In case of a night show, it will be necessary to provide lighting adapted to the playing space.



## **Home Ambulation/ Location :**

Plan for a complete tracing of the route with a person from the company on arrival.

Distance of the ideal walking route: about 800 meters.

Distance of the ideal course with the show: about 400 meters.

Average speed of the puppet: about 1.5 km per hour.

## **Constraints:**

Provide a locked or guarded storage place, from the team's arrival to its departure, if several consecutive days of play.

Warn if there are sidewalks to pass along the route and in the event of significant traffic.

Check that there are no cables, decorations or other across the street within 4 meters.

The puppet does not pass under tram cabling.

ATTENTION: In case of wandering at night, it will be necessary to provide volunteers to light the puppets. Approach the company to determine the appropriate number.
